

**Re: Support for Challenge to Court Order Releasing Approximately 1,800  
Inmates from Orange County Jails**

Dear Sheriff Barnes:

On behalf of the City of Garden Grove, I am writing to express the City's support for your challenge to the Court Order to reduce Orange County's Jail inmate population by fifty percent (50%). We understand that the American Civil Liberties Union, on behalf of Orange County inmates, filed a lawsuit alleging that inmates should be released because they are medically vulnerable and at imminent risk of serious illness and death from COVID-19. After considering the arguments, on December 11, 2020, the judge in the case ordered you to reduce the Orange County jail inmate population by fifty percent (50%) ("Court Order").

If forced to comply with the Court Order, we are aware you will need to release approximately 1,800 inmates, which both you and the Orange County District Attorney have stated unequivocally poses a significant risk to public safety. Specifically, you identified that of the 700 inmates considered medically vulnerable under the Center of Disease Control and Prevention's Guidelines, 59 inmates are incarcerated for murder, 39 inmates for attempted murder and 90 for child molestation.

This Court Order is especially concerning given that there have already been significant impacts on public safety related to the release of prisoners by the County of Orange and State of California related to COVID-19. For instance, since the pandemic began, the County of Orange has released thousands of inmates and the State of California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation has released over 22,000 inmates.

The release of so many prisoners in such a short timeframe is straining state and local law enforcement who are not only addressing traditional law enforcement issues but responding to law enforcement issues associated with the pandemic. We fully support your challenge because the Court Order does not sufficiently



contemplate the risk to the health, safety and welfare of Orange County residents created by the wholesale release of inmates. Also, the Court Order does not account for the approval of the COVID-19 vaccine.

Currently, the COVID-19 vaccine is being distributed and administered throughout the United States (including the State of California). California has received over 300,000 doses so far. Front line healthcare workers are the first to receive the vaccine and, based on the order of priority, first responders, including prison guards will likely be next to receive the vaccine. We further note that the National Commission on COVID-19 and Criminal Justice is recommending prison guards and inmates be prioritized to receive the vaccine. This information should be factored into any decision.

Based on the foregoing reasons, the City strongly supports your challenge to the Court Order to reduce the Orange County Jail inmate population by fifty percent (50%). 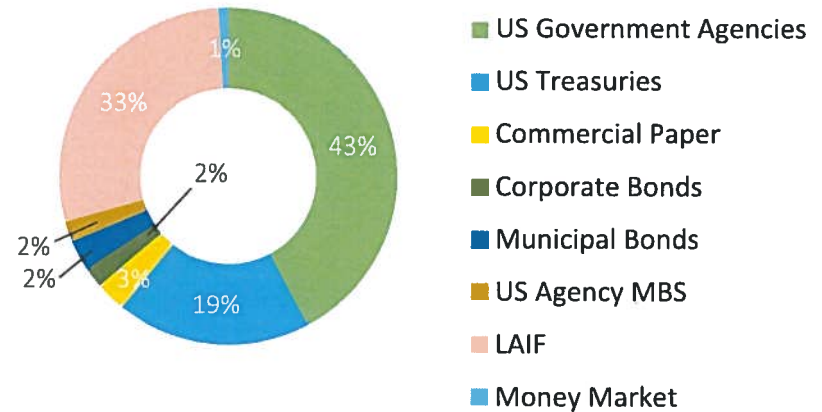

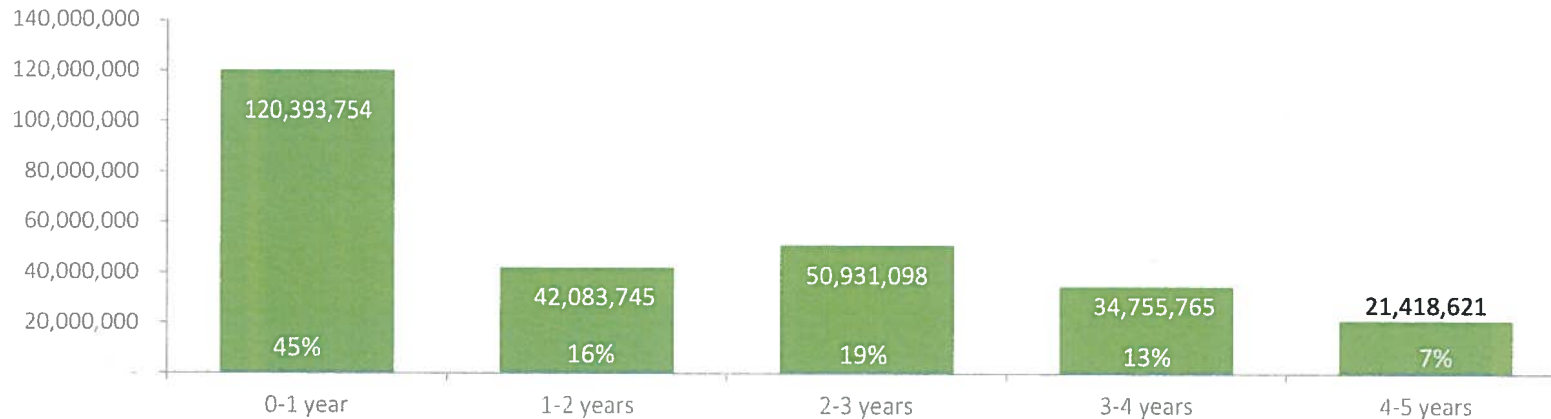

## Your Portfolio Distribution

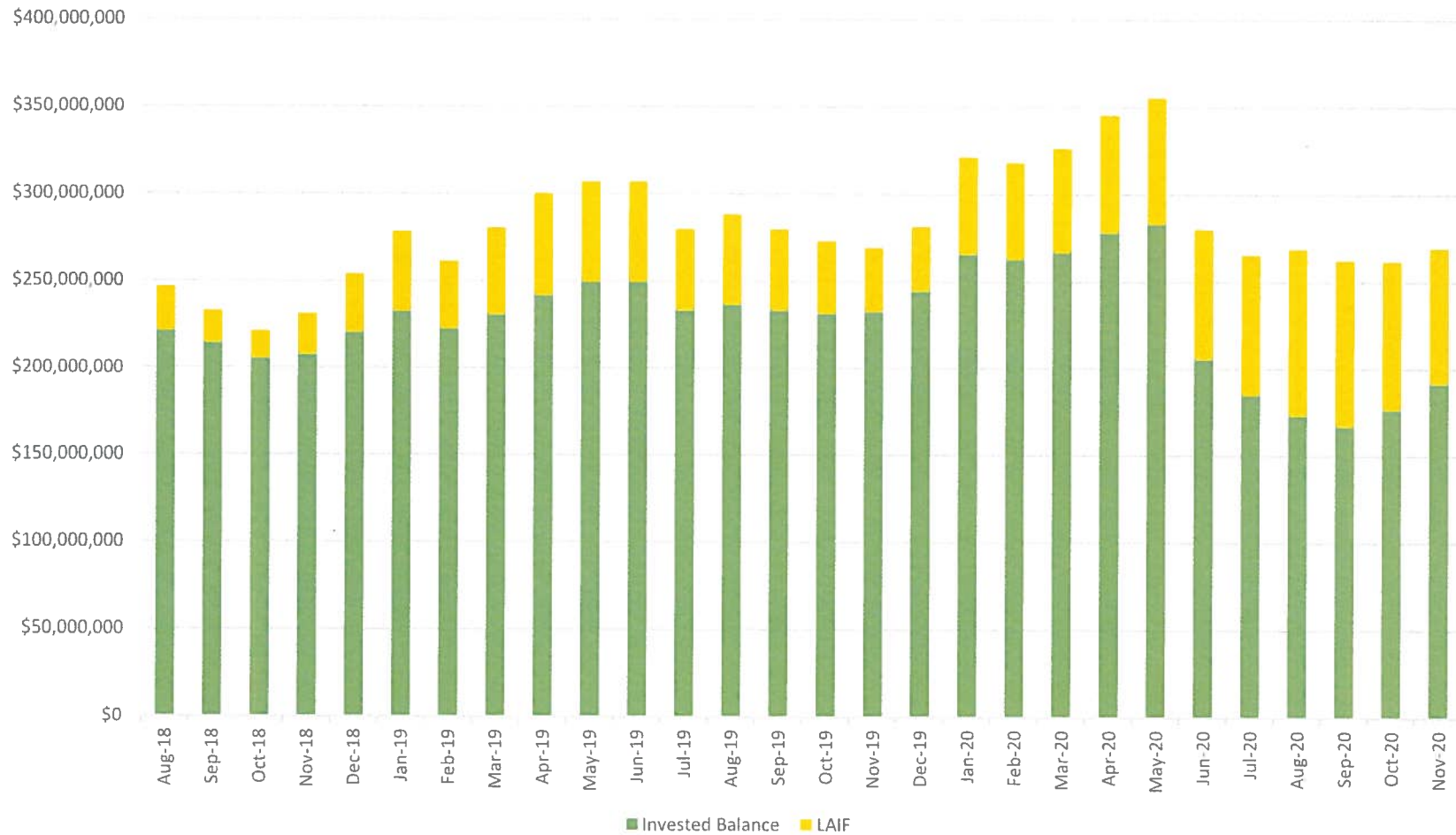

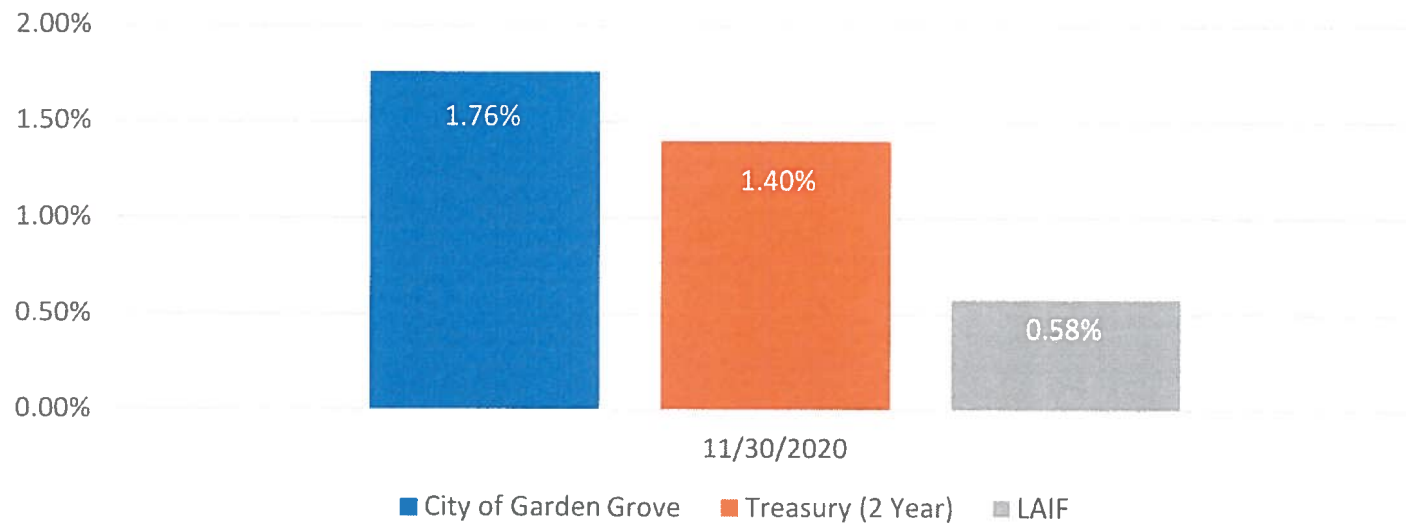

# MARKET COMMENTARY

November 2020

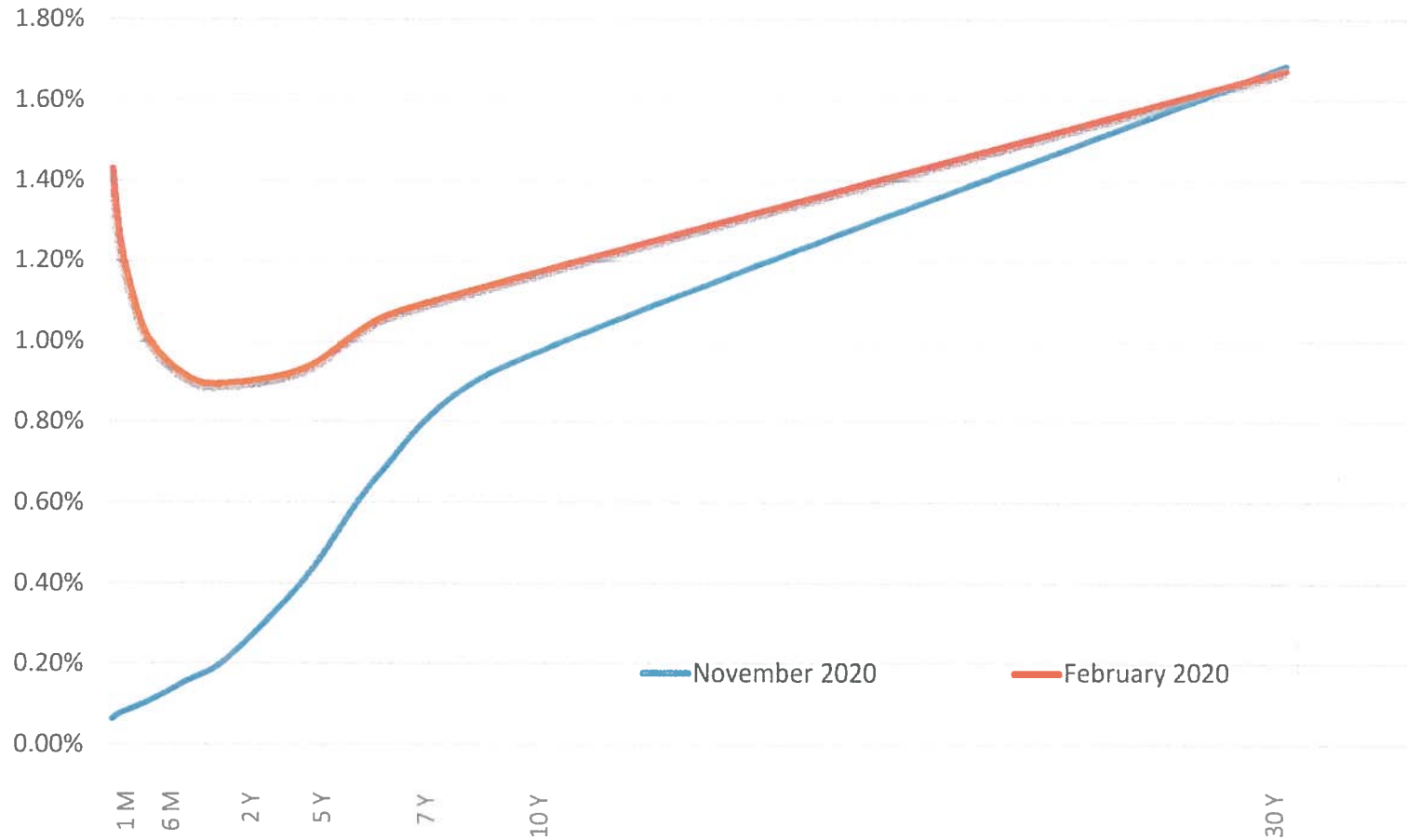
In the month of November, manufacturing PMI increased from 53.4 in October to 56.7, which is the highest level in 74 months and indicates strong growth ahead. This was mainly driven by very strong new domestic orders. In addition, sentiment improved substantially due to positive vaccine news and the end of the 2020 election cycle. The separate services PMI increased from 56.9 in October to 57.7, the highest in 68 months.

By no surprise, the FOMC decided to keep interest rates at 0-0.25% to support the recovering economy. Fed officials have indicated that they expect to keep rates this low for a number of years to help jobs return to pre-Covid levels, and push inflation modestly above 2% for a period of time to offset weak inflation. They also signaled that they may purchase more longer-term bonds to help further lower interest rates on debt like mortgages.

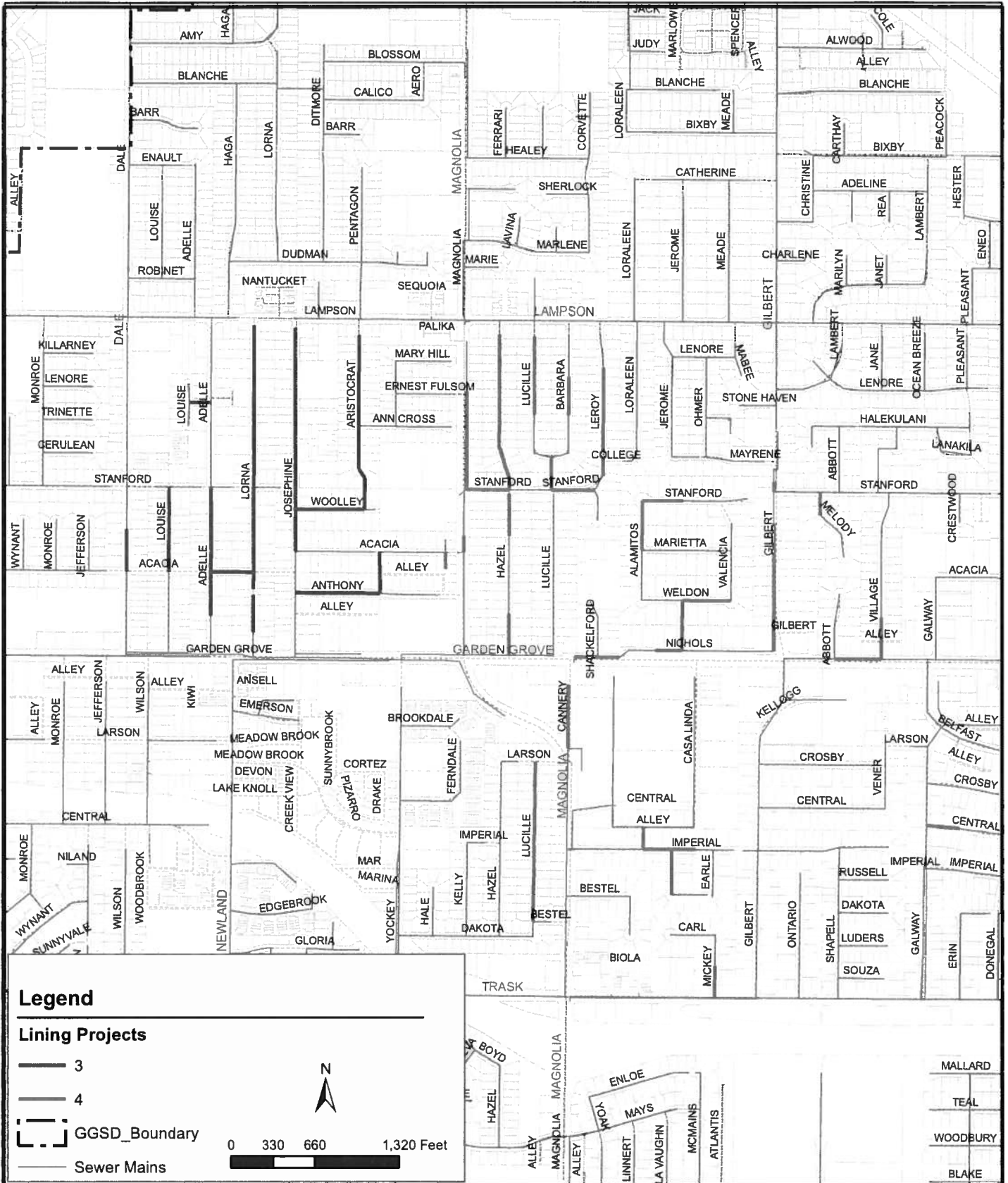

In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Title 32 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 651 and Army Regulation 200-1, the U.S. Army Reserve, 63d Readiness Division (RD) is providing notice that an Environmental Assessment (EA) is being prepared for public comment. Please take some time to review the following information and provide your comments regarding the subject undertaking.

The 63d RD proposes to relocate Detachment 1, Company B, 6th Battalion, 52nd Aviation Unit from Fort Hood, Texas to CA023 Joint Forces Training Base (JFTB) Los Alamitos, California (map provided as Enclosure). The relocation consists of 18 personnel and four UC-35A Cessna Citation Ultra aircraft. The aircraft are used to provide airlift to military personnel and Department of Defense civilians on official business within the continental U.S. The aircraft and personnel would move into the existing CA023 facility which has ample space inside and on the airport apron. CA023 is used for administrative services, classroom training, area maintenance and support, and vehicle and equipment storage. The relocation of personnel and aircraft does not require construction, renovation, demolition, or ground-disturbing activities.

Due to the nature and the location of the proposed action, we anticipate less than significant impacts to resources. Per the requirements of Title 32 CFR 651, all resources will be evaluated and assessed during the development of the EA and prior to a final decision on the proposed action by the 63d RD.

Compliance with all relevant environmental regulations such as Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act of 1973 and Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1969 will be accomplished concurrently.





The attached figures show the recent trend of water consumption in Orange County (OC), an estimate of Imported Water Sales for MWD OC, and selected water supply information.

- OC Water Usage, Monthly by Supply **OCWD Groundwater was the main supply in October.**
- OC Water Usage, Monthly, Comparison to Previous Years Water usage in **October 2020 was slightly above average compared to the last 5 years.** We are projecting a slight decrease in overall water usage compared to FY 2019-20. It has been 43 months since all mandatory water restrictions were lifted by the California State Water Resources Control Board.
- Historical OC Water Consumption Orange County M & I water consumption is **projected** to be **523,000 AF in FY 2020-21** (this includes ~15 TAF of agricultural usage and non-retail water agency usage). This is about **11,000 AF less than FY 2019-20** and is about **8,000 AF more than FY 2018-19**. Water usage per person is projected to be slightly lower in **FY 2020-21 for Orange County at 146 gallons per day** (This includes recycled water). Although OC population has increased 20% over the past two decades, water usage has not increased, on average. A long-term decrease in per-capita water usage is attributed mostly to Water Use Efficiency (water conservation) efforts. **O.C. Water Usage for the last five Fiscal Years is the lowest since the 1982-83 Fiscal Year** (FY 1982-83 was the third wettest year on record).

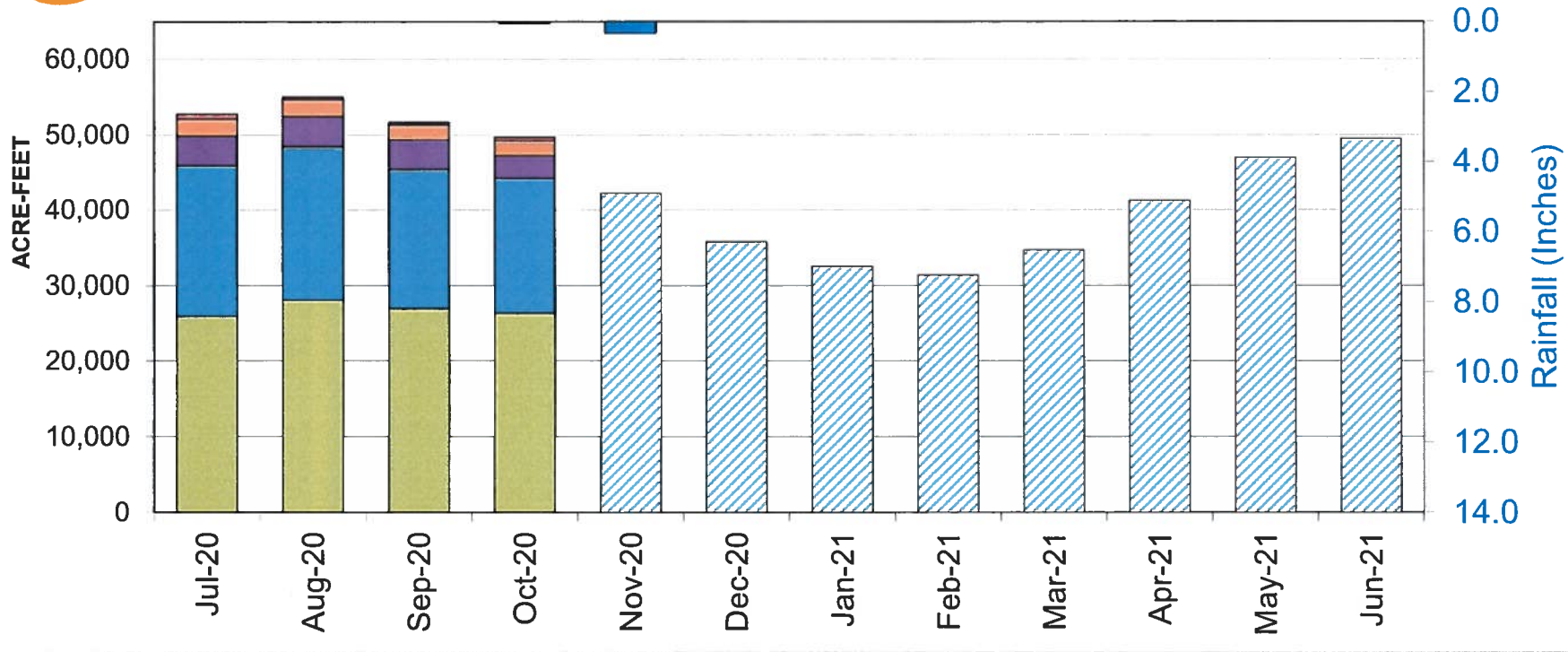
Water Supply Information Includes data on Rainfall in OC; the OCWD Basin overdraft; Northern California and Colorado River Basin hydrologic data; the State Water Project (SWP) Allocation, and regional storage volumes. The data have implications for the magnitude of supplies from the three watersheds that are the principal sources of water for OC. Note that a hydrologic year is Oct. 1<sup>st</sup> through Sept. 30<sup>th</sup>.

- Orange County's accumulated precipitation through **early December** was below average for this period. Water year to date rainfall in Orange County is **0.38 inches**, which is **22% of normal**.
- Northern California accumulated precipitation through **early December** was **9% of normal for this period**. Water Year 2020 was 63% of normal while water year 2019 was 137% of normal. The **Northern California snowpack** has not been reported for WY 2021. **As of late November, 75.03%** of California is experiencing **moderate to extreme drought conditions** while 96.50% of the state is experiencing abnormally dry conditions. The State Water Project Contractors Table A Allocation was increased to 20% in May 2020.
- Colorado River Basin accumulated precipitation through **early December** was **60% of normal** for this period. The **Upper Colorado Basin snowpack** was **76% of normal** as of November 30<sup>th</sup>. **Lake Mead and Lake Powell** combined have about **58% of their average storage volume** for this time of year and are at **41.3% of their total capacity**. If Lake Mead's **level falls below a "trigger" limit 1,075 ft. at the end of a calendar year**, then a shortage will be declared by the US Bureau of Reclamation (USBR), impacting Colorado River water deliveries to the Lower Basin states. As of early October, Lake Mead levels were **6.07' above the "trigger" limit**. The USBR predicts that the start of 2020 will not hit the "trigger" level but there is a **0% chance that the trigger level will be hit in 2021 and a 23% chance in 2022**.



**Fig. 1 OC Water Usage, Monthly by Supply with projection to end of fiscal year**

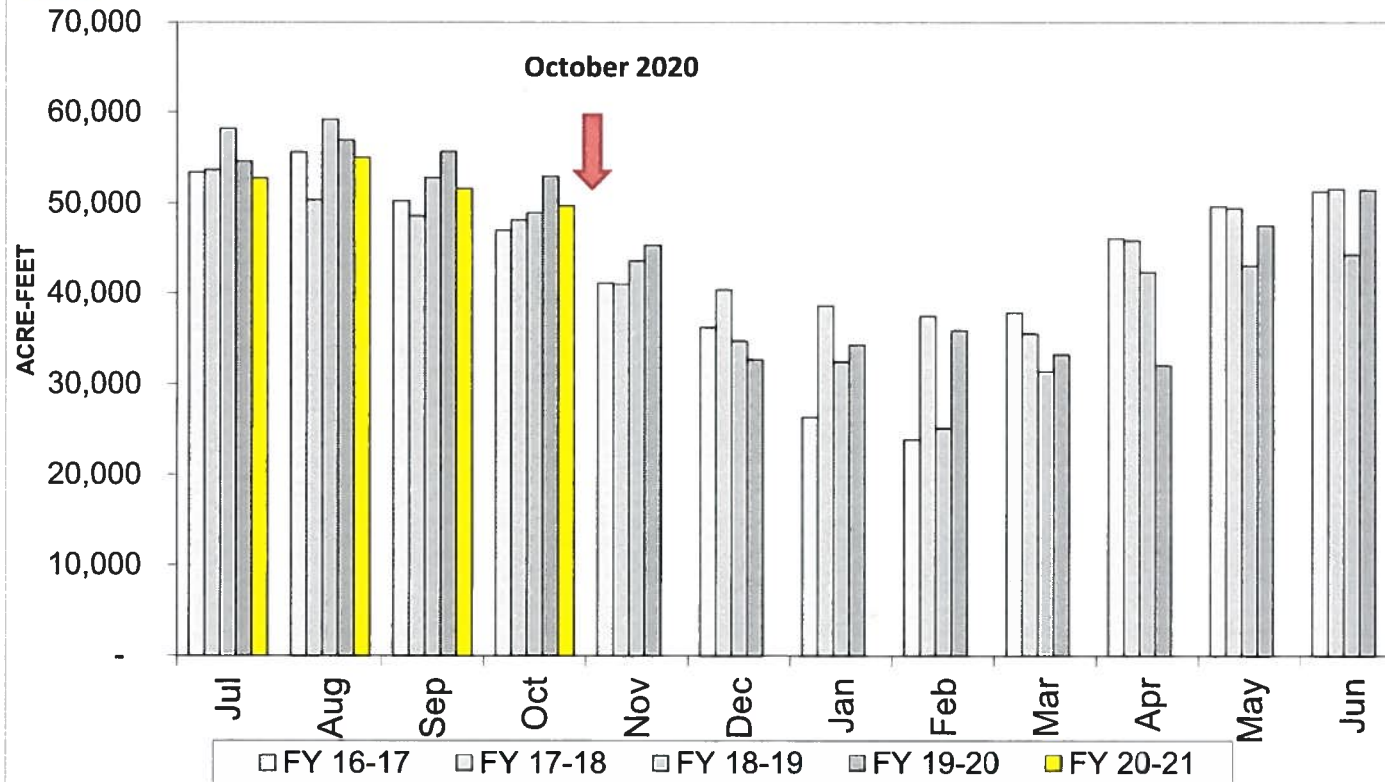

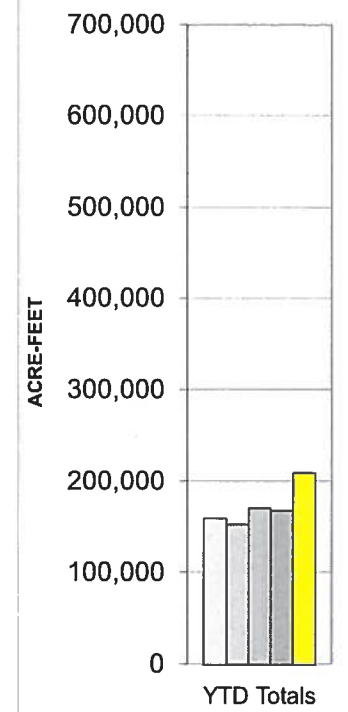

**Fig. 2 OC Monthly Water Usage [1]: Comparison to Last 4 Fiscal Years**

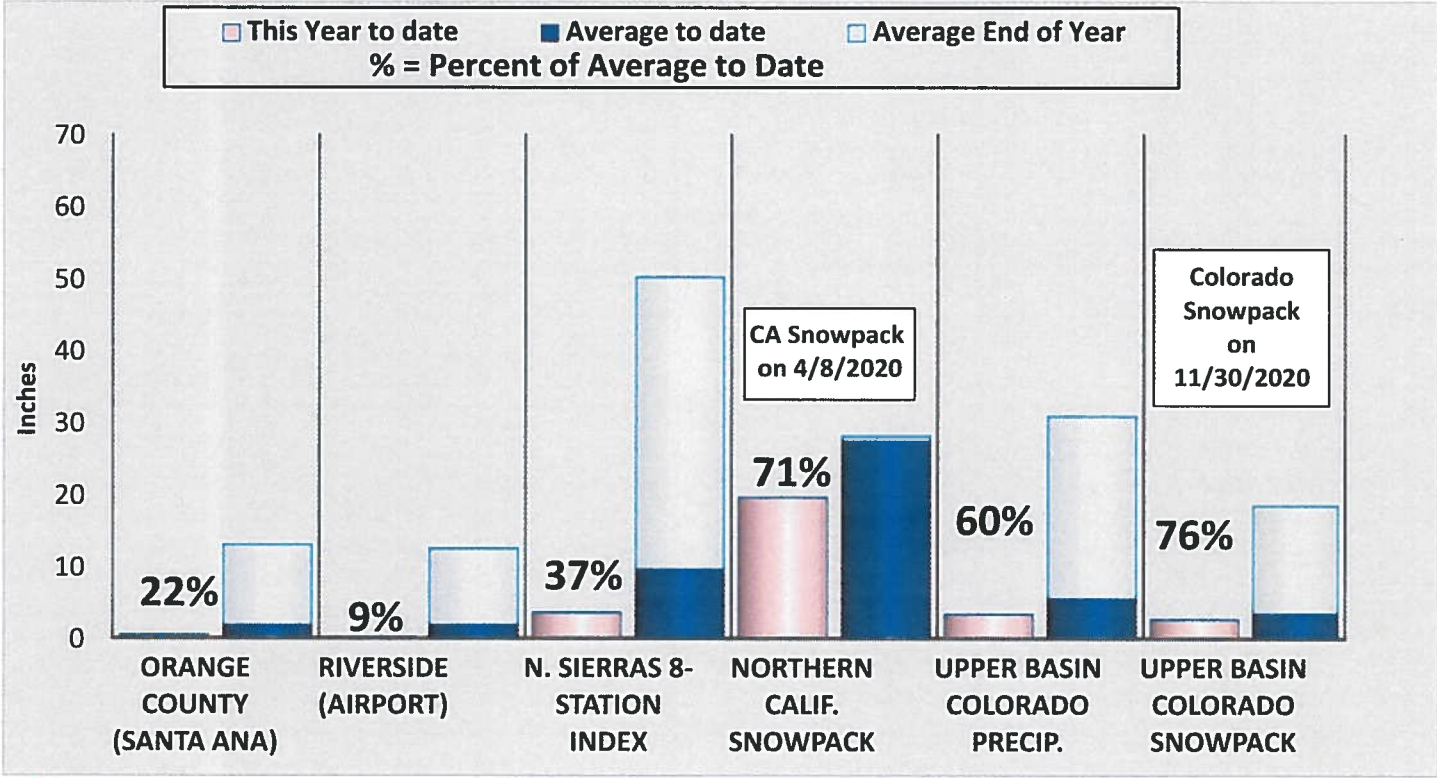

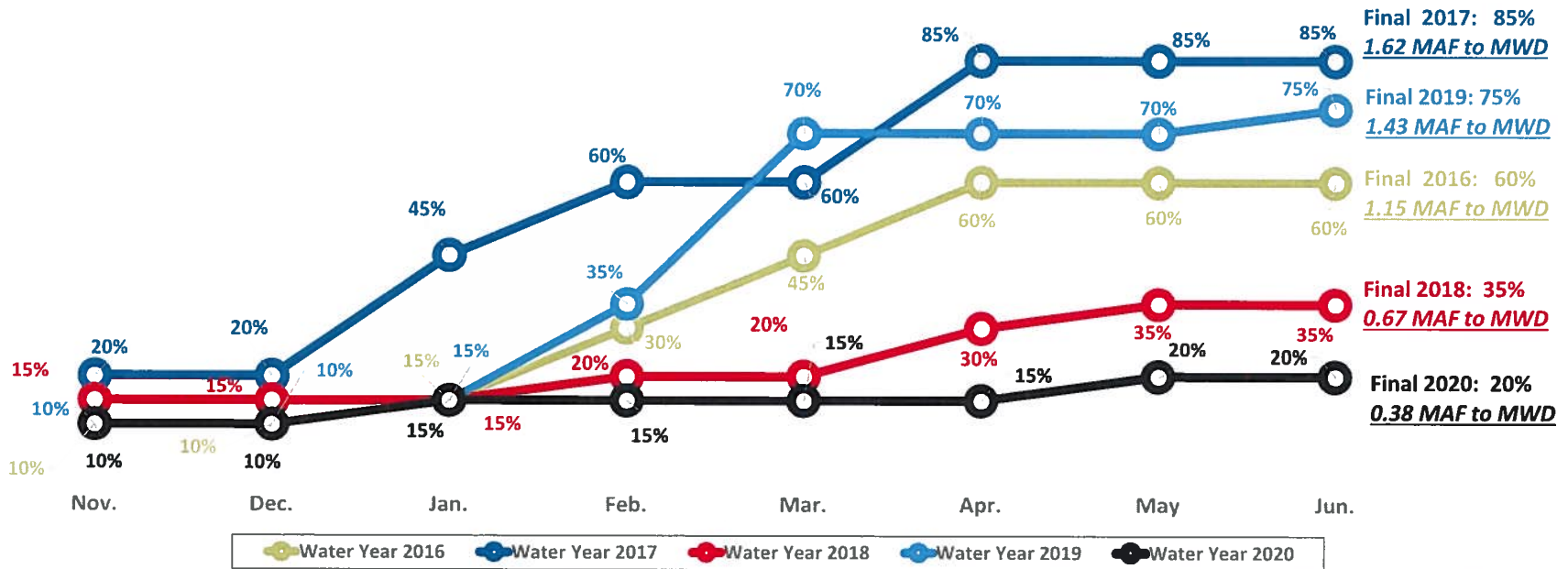
# Accumulated Precipitation for the Oct.-Sep. water year, early December 2020

as of December 1, 2020

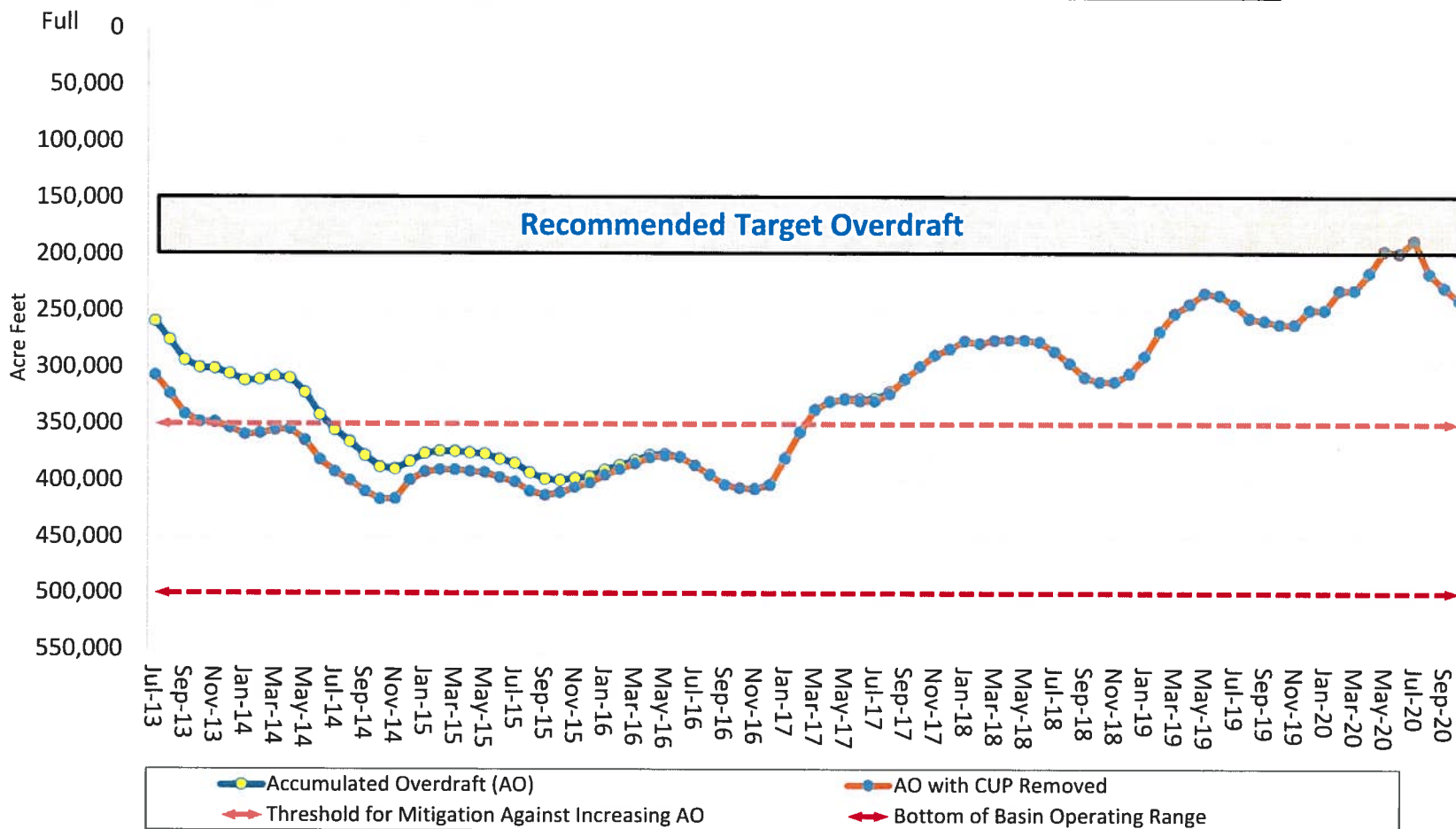

## Accumulated Overdraft of the OCWD Groundwater Basin as of November 2020

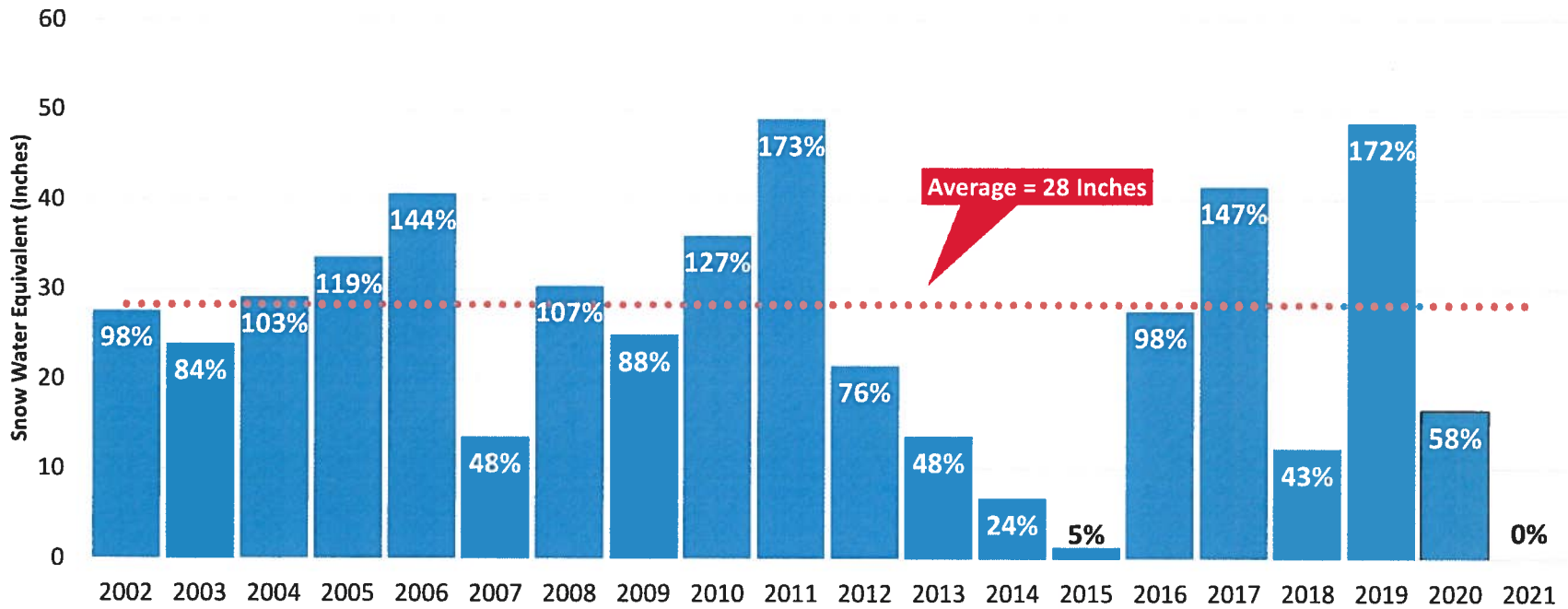

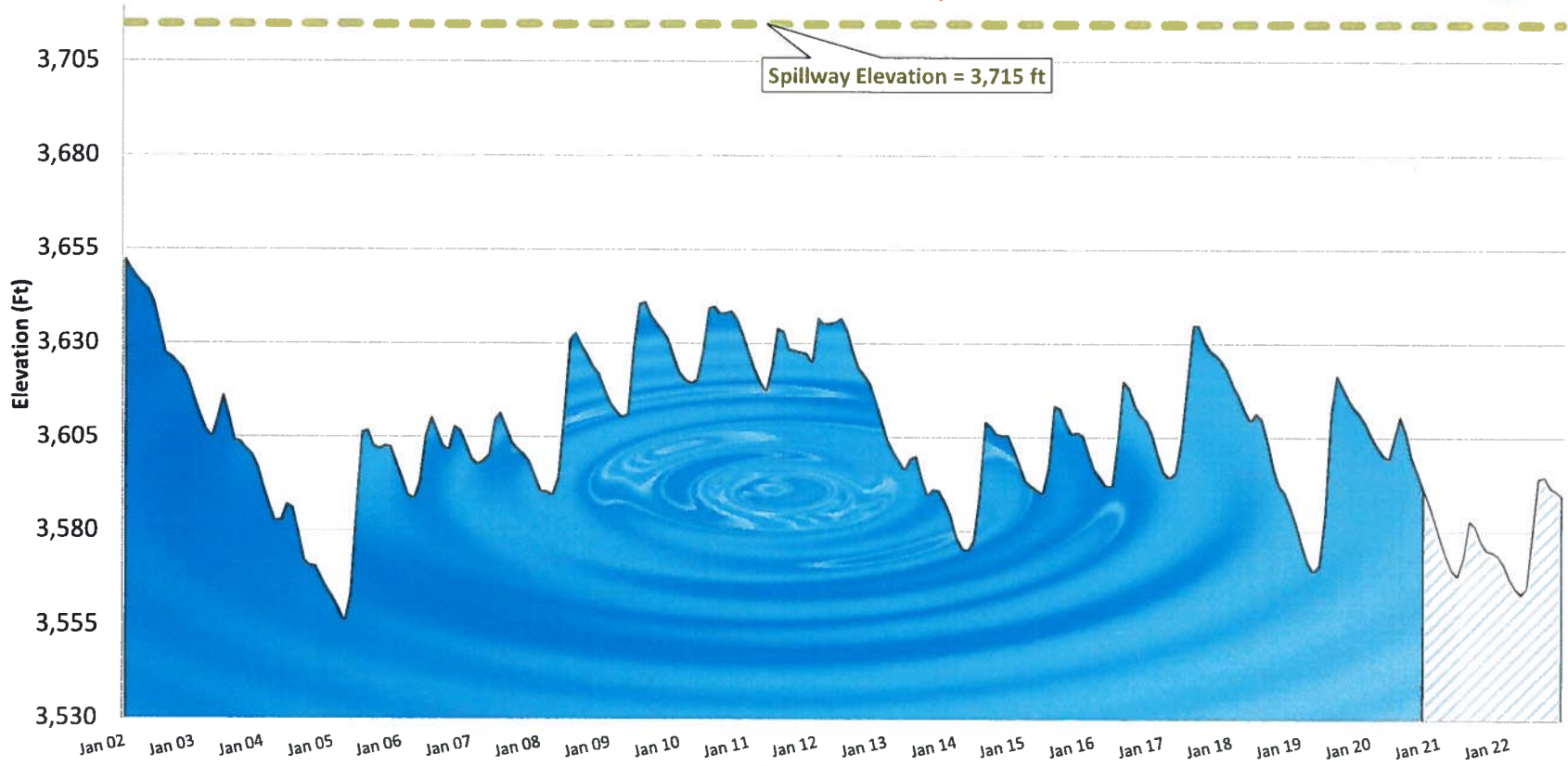


## Lake Mead Historical Water Elevation Level

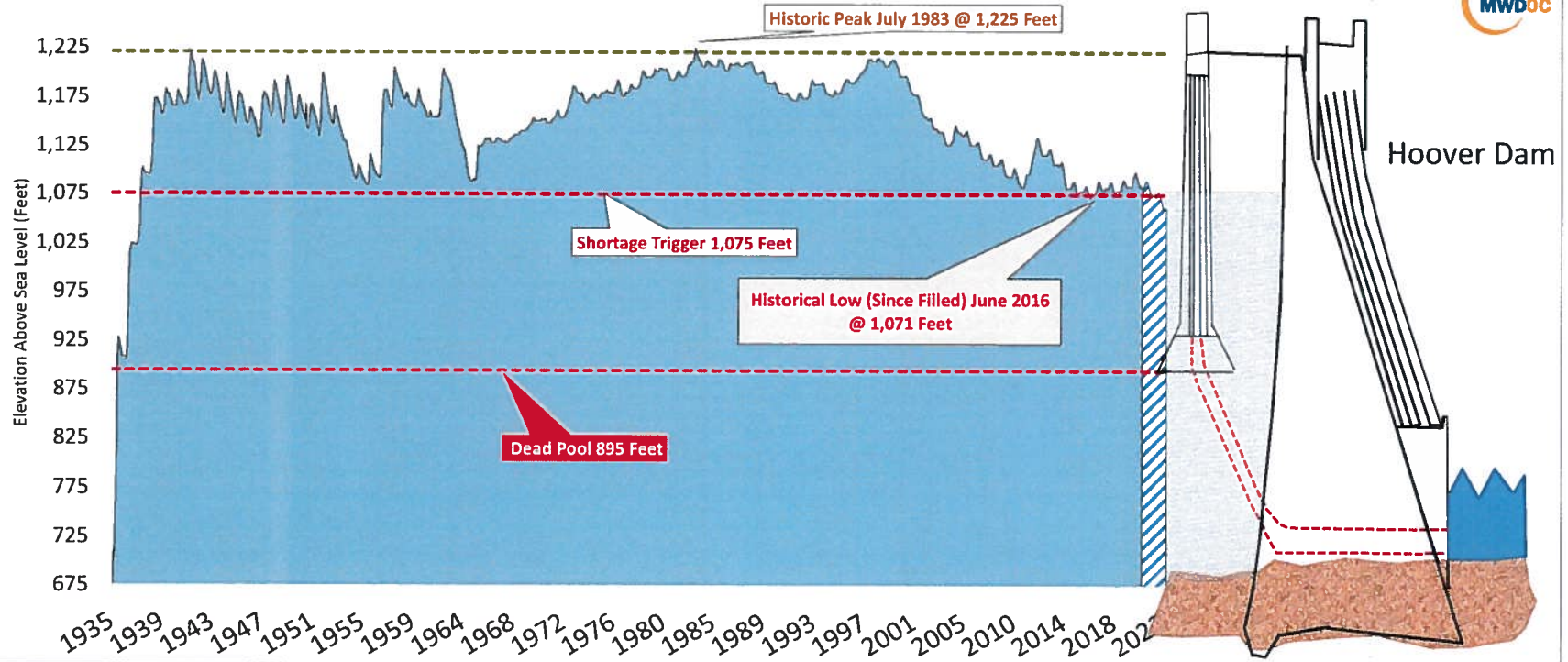


## Lake Powell Levels: Historical and Projected projection per USBR 24-Month Study

## Point in Time Count Cancelled Due to COVID-19

Santa Ana, Calif. (December 21, 2020) The County of Orange is among several Continuums of Care (CoC) in Southern California that have been approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to forgo the Unsheltered Count of the 2021 Point In Time due to the impacts of COVID-19.

HUD is still requiring CoCs to complete the Sheltered Count and Homeless Inventory Counts (HIC), which are an annual mandate that occurs concurrently with the biennial unsheltered count process. The Sheltered Count and the HIC will be completed during the last week of January working in collaboration with 2-1-1 Orange County. The majority of Southern California COCs have made similar requests and been approved by HUD to not conduct their count of unsheltered individuals experiencing homelessness.

The Point in Time is a biennial effort required by HUD counting people experiencing homelessness in a given point in time during the last 10 days in January.

***Permanent Closure of Aliso Viejo Regional Center, Effective December 31, 2020;  
Re-opening of Laguna Hills Regional Center Slated for January 4, 2021***

**Orange County, Calif.** (December 23, 2020) – The County of Orange Social Services Agency (SSA) announced that its Aliso Viejo Regional Center (AVRC) located at 115 Columbia will close its doors on December 31, 2020. AVRC core operations and staff will be consolidated into SSA’s nearby Laguna Hills Regional Center (LHRC), located at 23330 Moulton Parkway, scheduled to re-open on January 4, 2021.

The decision to close AVRC was made as a result of the Agency’s analysis of long-term cost savings associated with the closure and determination that the consolidation of multiple programs into LHRC will allow SSA to more effectively serve the community.

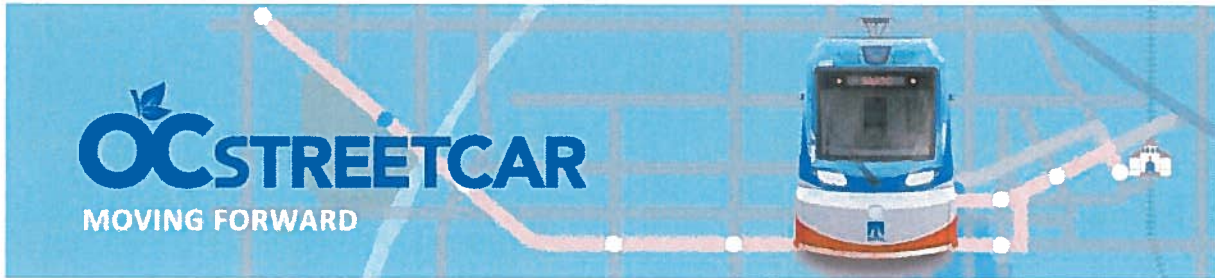

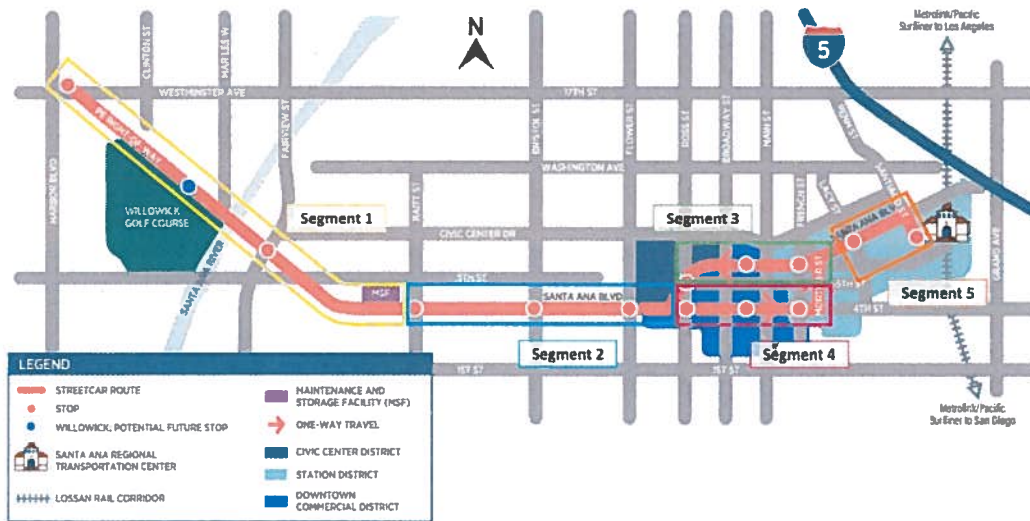

**Why am I receiving this notice?**

On December 17, 2020 Southern California Edison Company (SCE) filed its Application for Authorization to Recover Costs Related to July 2020- December 31, 2020 Wildfire Insurance Premiums Recorded in its Wildfire Expense Memorandum Account (A.20-12-010) with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC). The application is requesting a total of \$214.5 Million.

If the CPUC approves this application, SCE will recover those costs in electric distribution rates over a one-year period beginning January 1, 2022. This will impact your monthly bill.

**Why is SCE requesting this rate increase?**

- SCE annually purchases wildfire liability insurance to protect customers against third-party legal claims that are made after wildfire events associated with SCE's equipment.
- The CPUC includes wildfire liability premium costs in customer rates, customarily through General Rate Cases. This application seeks recovery of insurance costs that are in addition to the costs currently included in customer rates, because wildfire liability insurance has become more expensive in recent years.

**How could this affect my monthly electric rates?**

If SCE's rate request is approved by the CPUC, the average non-CARE residential monthly bill using 500 kWh per month would increase by approximately \$1.91 or 1.7% per month at the start of 2022. The average CARE tiered residential monthly bill with the same monthly usage would increase by approximately \$1.29 or 1.7% per month.

This application will be assigned to a CPUC Administrative Law Judge who will consider proposals and evidence presented during the formal hearing process. The Administrative Law Judge will issue a



proposed decision that may adopt SCE's application, modify it, or deny it. Any CPUC Commissioner may sponsor an alternate decision with a different outcome. The proposed decision, and any alternate decisions, will be discussed and voted upon by the CPUC Commissioners at a public CPUC Voting Meeting.

Parties to the proceeding are currently reviewing SCE's application, including the Public Advocates Office, which is an independent consumer advocate within the CPUC that represents customers to obtain the lowest possible rate for service consistent with reliable and safe service levels. Dear Sheriff Barnes:

On behalf of the City of Garden Grove, I am writing to express the City's support for your challenge to the Court Order to reduce Orange County's Jail inmate population by fifty percent (50%). We understand that the American Civil Liberties Union, on behalf of Orange County inmates, filed a lawsuit alleging that inmates should be released because they are medically vulnerable and at imminent risk of serious illness and death from COVID-19. After considering the arguments, on December 11, 2020, the judge in the case ordered you to reduce the Orange County jail inmate population by fifty percent (50%) ("Court Order").

If forced to comply with the Court Order, we are aware you will need to release approximately 1,800 inmates, which both you and the Orange County District Attorney have stated unequivocally poses a significant risk to public safety. Specifically, you identified that of the 700 inmates considered medically vulnerable under the Center of Disease Control and Prevention's Guidelines, 59 inmates are incarcerated for murder, 39 inmates for attempted murder and 50 for child molestation.

The Court Order is especially concerning given that there have already been significant impacts on public safety related to the release of prisoners by the County of Orange and State of California related to COVID-19. For instance, since the pandemic began, the County of Orange has released thousands of inmates and the State of California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation has released over 1,000 inmates.

The release of so many prisoners in such a short timeframe is straining state and local law enforcement who are not only addressing traditional law enforcement issues but responding to law enforcement issues associated with the pandemic. We

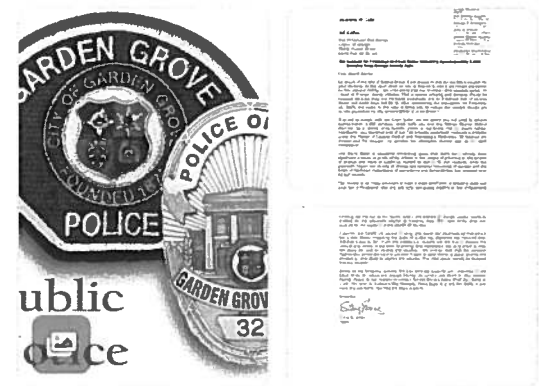

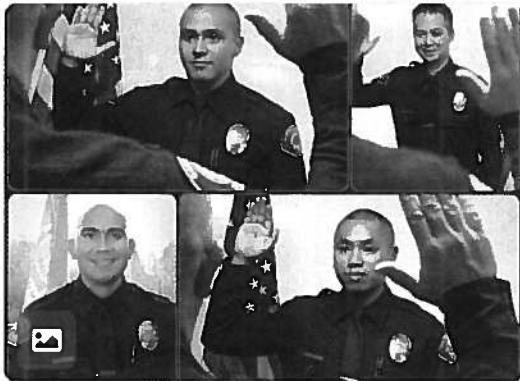

The Orange County Transportation Authority is proud that it has begun laying track for the OC Streetcar — a \$408-million, low-speed, 4.1-mile rail line that the agency boasts is “connecting our communities with tomorrow.” Unfortunately, a streetcar powered by overhead electric lines is not a transportation option of the future, but an old-school system that is unlikely to make a dent in traffic.

We’re not against rail per se, but every transportation proposal needs to pass the basic cost-and-benefit smell test. The streetcar, which should be running by early 2023, will meander around Santa Ana and Garden Grove, connecting the Santa Ana Transit Center with the Civic Center and public-transportation hubs including Amtrak, Metrolink and OCTA bus stops.

Supporters envision the initial line as a starter segment for a countywide system, but it’s hard to imagine that the boutique system will do much more than divert funds from fundamental improvements to the street and freeway systems that most people in Orange County depend upon.

At nearly \$100 million per mile, the OC Streetcar is unlikely to reduce congestion in a county with thousands of miles of roads and freeways. We agree with the libertarian Cato Institute's transportation expert Randal O'Toole, who notes that "streetcar technology is 130 years old and has since been replaced by less expensive, more flexible buses." He views all streetcar projects as "boondoggles."

OCTA officials could not have predicted the COVID-19 crisis, which has hammered transit ridership. But even before the pandemic, public-transportation ridership had fallen so precipitously that it was posing a crisis for most American cities, according to a 2018 Washington Post report.

Orange County's transit situation has been similarly bleak. Anaheim's 67,000 square-foot ARTIC (Anaheim Regional Transportation Intermodal Center) rises impressively above the 57 Freeway like an alien spaceship — but its ridership numbers are low even though it no longer is draining the city's budget.

County officials ought to prioritize cost-effective transportation-engineering projects such as roads and buses rather than social-engineering projects that attempt to change the way we get around.

## Three developers, plus Orange County, looking at Willowick Golf Course land

Two Garden Grove council members reconsider whether they want to sell the city's golf course, which sits in Santa Ana

Three developers are eyeing the Willowick Golf Course in Santa Ana in the latest discussion about what will be built on one of the last large pieces of open land in Central Orange County.

A fourth proposal, from the county, would turn 20 acres of the 102-acre parcel into a regional park.

The property could generate between \$2.13 million to \$100 million or Garden Grove if sold or leased to one of the three developers. And any commercial project on the property might boost future tax revenue.

The golf course is in the city of Santa Ana but it is owned by the city of Garden Grove. It's adjacent to the Santa Ana River and the future OC Streetcar system, which had its first rails installed this month.



On Dec. 8, the Garden Grove City Council moved to authorize its staff to negotiate with the three developers. But the 5-2 vote showed some cracks in the city's support to sell the land.

Councilman George Brietigam said he's now having second thoughts about whether it's a good idea to sell the public land.

"The more we get into this, the more I'm leaning to just leave it as a golf course, maybe redesign it, update it, maybe incorporate a water park to make money," Brietigam said Monday.

"I'm not in a rush to sell it or lease it," he said.

Neither is Councilman Phat Bui, who tried to put the brakes on the council's vote to proceed with 90-day negotiations with three developers and Orange County.

In an interview Monday, Bui expressed concerns about fairness and transparency with the project. Bui said he leans against selling the property but would consider leasing it if it's "something that really benefits the community."

As he did during the meeting, Bui expressed repeated concerns that the city could be sued again, as it was last year.

During the Dec. 8 council meeting, Mayor Steve Jones said the city plans to engage in good faith negotiations and follow the law. To his two colleagues expressing concern, Jones said he suggested council members "cool our jets" and follow the staff's recommendations. The council majority authorized the city manager to begin negotiating with:

- Willowick Community Partners, formed by City Ventures, Jamboree Housing and Primestor companies, which wants to buy or lease the property to develop a plan "anchored by a regional riverfront park" and featuring a mixed-use development with 1,690 residential units, 70,000 square feet of commercial space, and 34.8 acres of public open space.
- The non-profits Trust for Public Land, State Coastal Conservancy and the Clifford Beers Housing, which want to buy the land and develop a regional nature park and/or open space with some 270 affordable housing units. The site would also include a multi-purpose "Welcome Center & Plaza" and community rooms in what's now the golf club building.
- McWhinney Land LLC and Wakeland Housing, which wants a 55-year lease to create an 18-hour-day community with a mixed use development plan, including open spaces, residences, retail, dining and entertainment "and the potential for a specialized land use, such as a stadium, arena, or civic use, that could serve as the centerpiece to the community." McWhinney was the developer selected last year for a project at Willowick before litigation from a community group stopped it.

Last October, a community organization known as OCCORD, Orange County Communities Organized for Responsible Development, sued both Garden Grove and Santa Ana. The lawsuit alleged the cities violated the state's Surplus Land Act, which calls for public land to be prioritized for affordable housing and open space uses, such as public parks.

Then, in December, Garden Grove attempted to push through a long-term development lease with MWillowick Land LLC, affiliated with McWhinney Real Estate Services, Inc. City officials appeared at the time to try to be getting around a new law before it kicked in Jan. 1, 2020: a new version of the Surplus Land Act. And a Los Angeles Superior Court judge agreed, issuing a temporary restraining order Dec. 17. That lawsuit was settled earlier this year, when the council agreed to pay a \$388,469 settlement.

Forced to conform with the new law, the Garden Grove City Council in February declared the property “surplus land.” And the process began anew, with the city asking developers for proposals.

Cynthia Guerra, an organizer with the Rise Up Willowick Coalition, said her group of Santa Ana and Garden Grove residents support the proposal from the non-profits that want to focus on open space and possibly low to moderate-priced housing.

“It’s the only one that uses the land entirely for public benefit,” Guerra said.

“This is a once in a lifetime opportunity to get urgently needed open space in the area,” she said.

It’s unclear when the next step will take place. A 90-day process to begin negotiations with those who submitted proposals has not yet begun. That’s expected after the city receives some clarification from the non-profits for its proposal, city spokeswoman Ana Pulido wrote in an e-mail.
